

# Silent-E Spelling Rules

**Jumps over 1 blue tile to make a vowel long** (luck, Luke)

**Long vowel plus one consonant or digraph  
one-syllable word:**

**A, I, O, or U = Silent-E** (safe, pine, rope, rude)

**E = EE** (feet)

**last syllable of multi-syllable word:**

**A, E, I, O, or U = Silent-E** (complete)

**/z/ at end = se** (rise)

**/s/ at end = ce** most of the time (rice)

**/j/ at end = huge bridge**

**/jee/ at end = gy** (strategy)

**/v/ at end = ve** (have)

**/iv/ at end = ive** (expensive)

**/cher/ at end = ture** (nature, natural)

**only consonants at end = consonant-LE** (bottle)

**/sl/ at end = sle or stle or cel** (hassle, cancel, whistle)

look it up using the sounds you can hear

**/cl/ at end = sprinkle vehicle** (but not uncle, cycle, circle)

unless it's a suffix: tropic, tropical
