## Silent-E Spelling Rules

## Jumps over 1 blue tile to make a vowel long (luck, Luke)

Long vowel plus one consonant or digraph one-syllable word:

A, $\mathbf{I}, \mathbf{O}$, or $\mathbf{U}=$ Silent-E (safe, pine, rope, rude)
$\mathbf{E}=\mathbf{E} \mathbf{E}$ (feet)
last syllable of multi-syllable word:
$\mathbf{A}, \mathbf{E}, \mathbf{I}, \mathbf{O}$, or $\mathbf{U}=$ Silent $-\mathbf{E} \quad$ (complete)
$/ \mathrm{z} /$ at end $=\mathbf{s e}$ (rise)
/s/at end = ce most of the time (rice)
$/ j /$ at end = huge bridge
/jee/ at end = gy (strategy)
$/ \mathbf{v} /$ at end $=$ ve (have)
/iv/ at end = ive (expensive)
/cher/ at end = ture (nature, natural)
only consonants at end = consonant-LE (bottle)
/sl/ at end = sle or stle or cel (hassle, cancel, whistle)
look it up using the sounds you can hear
/cl/ at end = sprinkle vehicle (but not uncle, cycle, circle) unless it's a suffix: tropic, tropical
