Reminders for Tutors

Plural: use ES if you couldn't *hear* S or baseword ends in O if Y to I, add ES

Doubling Rule: ends with CVC and accented + vowel suffix

Change Rule: change Y to I + any kind of suffix Unless suffix starts with I or Y is part of a vowel team

/zhun/ is always SION

/shun/ after most consonants is TION After L = SION After N, look it up as ?ion

/shun/ after a Long vowel is TION

/shun/ after most short vowels is TION

Or else S + SION

Reminders for Tutors

Six Reasons for Silent-E:

 make the vowel long 	*/z/ at end = SE	* /s/ at end = CE
• V can't be at the end	• $/j$ at end = GE, DGE	 Consonant-LE

Huge Bridge: the only time you use DGE is right after a short vowel.

Silent-E Units:

 /is/ = office, palace 	 /ij/ = pack<u>age</u> 	/in/ = engine
 /it/ = opposite, chocolate 	/cher/ = nature	

Dropping Rule: Drop Silent-E when adding a vowel suffix Unless CE or GE and adding AL, ABLE, or OUS Drop Y if adding IC or IZE

Greek Words: PH and Y in the middle

TION-SION: only "dumb, stupid letters" use SION

Sprinkle Vehicle: If 2 syllables, use KLE – except uncle, cycle, circle
