## Jumps over 1 blue tile to make a vowel long (luck, Luke) Long vowel plus one consonant or digraph

 one-syllable word:$\mathbf{A}, \mathbf{I}, \mathbf{O}$, or $\mathbf{U}=$ Silent $-\mathbf{E} \quad$ (safe, pine, rope, rude)
$\mathbf{E}=\mathbf{E} \mathbf{E}$ (feet)
last syllable of multi-syllable word:
A, $\mathbf{E}, \mathbf{I}, \mathbf{O}$, or $\mathrm{U}=$ Silent $-\mathbf{E}$ (complete)
$/ z /$ at end $=\mathbf{s e}$ (rise)
/s/at end = ce most of the time (rice)
/j/ at end = ge (huge)
/jee/ at end = gy (strategy)
